



This modified opening will NOT be open to the public. It is **only** for members of CCC and/or those that regularly attend. Regular attendance is considered to have attended at least six times between January through March 2020.

The following are the guidelines under which we will be working in order to be in compliance with our governmental agencies. Please note that there are many changes happening and that we are doing our best to stay on top of it, so please check our website often. You will receive emails less often than the website is updated.

THE GUIDELINES FOLLOW:

Please understand that we will expect each person to adhere to some specific guidelines. This is NOT the time to express your agreement or disagreement with the guidelines. This is how we as a church and its leaders have decided to “partially open up”:

- Face masks/coverings (over the nose & mouth) are required to enter and must be worn while inside.
- ONLY nuclear families can sit close to each other, all others will be seated in seats that are pre-spaced. Please ask the usher to help you, and do not move the chairs yourselves.
- Your temperature will be taken before entering. Those with a temperature of 100.4 F or higher will not be allowed to enter but asked to view the service from home.
- If you use the restroom, please clean up and disinfect after yourself. Supplies are provided.
- We had the entire church cleaned, sanitized, wiped and prayed for (what else is there)?
- You may not congregate before or after the service...it is called “anti-social” distancing.
- We will NOT be having a family-style lunch after service as usual.
- Doors will open at 10:15am
- Please be patient with us as we also struggle through this. No one likes this, but at least we can join together as family.
- Bring your own Bible and water (in a sealable bottle).
- There will be no classes (Nursery, Youth, or GSC) on Sunday.

VERY IMPORTANT!!!

- If you have any FLU-like symptoms, stay home.
- If you are nervous or scared, stay home.
- If you are under doctor’s care, stay home.
- If you are elderly and feel compromised, stay home.
- If you have a cough, stay home.
- If you are in a bad mood or having a bad hair day, stay home.
